

Just a quick reminder to start this week of our policy on snacks in school. Can we ask parent/carers to ensure all food with our whole school food policy.

Early Years/Key Stage One

Nursery children have access to free milk and fruit. For children in Reception to Year Two, we provide water and fruit at break time. In addition, children may bring a still drink or snack - fresh or dried fruit, carrot or rice cakes for morning break-time.

Biscuits, sweets, chocolate bars, crisps etc. are not permitted.

<u>Key Stage Two</u>

Children are allowed to bring in a small named bottle of water to drink in class.

In KS2, we ask families to provide a break time snack in line with school packed lunch guidelines.

Children should not bring any food containing nuts or snacks high in fat and sugar to school. We recommend fruit, vegetables or rice cakes.

Biscuits, sweets, chocolate bars, crisps etc. are not permitted.

For those of you who were at the Young Voices concert earlier in the year—exciting news! There may be further strike action next week on the 15th and 16th of March.
