KEY INFO FOR PARENTS

- **If everyone helps out, we maximise the fun for all:** we are asking every family attending the Fair to help out for a short period to make it a success – there will be lots of free activities to entertain the kids whilst parents are volunteering, and adults on every exit gate.
- **Year group stalls:** your year group's Stall Lead will be asking for volunteers to help man the stall(s) allocated to your year group and assist with set up and clear up.
- **Donation requests:** we will be asking parents to donate prizes for the tombola (adult + kids), second-hand soft toys, and/or some stall-specific items including tablecloths and decorations. More info to follow after half-term, but if you are decluttering over the break please bear this in mind!
- **Art Fair:** the main Fair will take place in the playground as usual, but parents will enter via an exhibition of the children's artwork in the hall. Mrs Adams is working on a specific project and the works will be available to buy in return for a donation to FoSMS.
- **Promises Auction – online and live at the Fair:** a Promises Auction will replace the Summer Raffle - no hampers to prepare this year! Auction lots will include both items and "promises" e.g. an evening of babysitting, baking a birthday cake, a weekend in a holiday home etc. More info to follow later this week but please start thinking about what you can offer!
- **External stalls welcome:** stalls for businesses run by school parents are welcome at the Fair this year in return for a donation to FoSMS – please speak to Ruth Allen or Rochelle Pearson for more info.
- **Token sales:** The Fair will once again operate mainly on the basis of tokens (1 token = £1). Buy your tokens in advance and save - £10 for 11 tokens – and save time on the day by collecting your tokens at the entrance gate.
